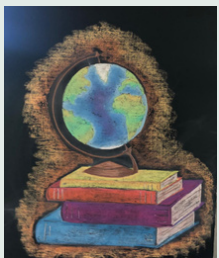
PRIMARY SCHOOL



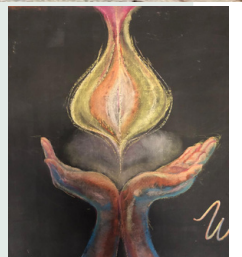
The Class 1, 2 and 3 students were warmly welcomed through a rose ceremony during our first assembly.

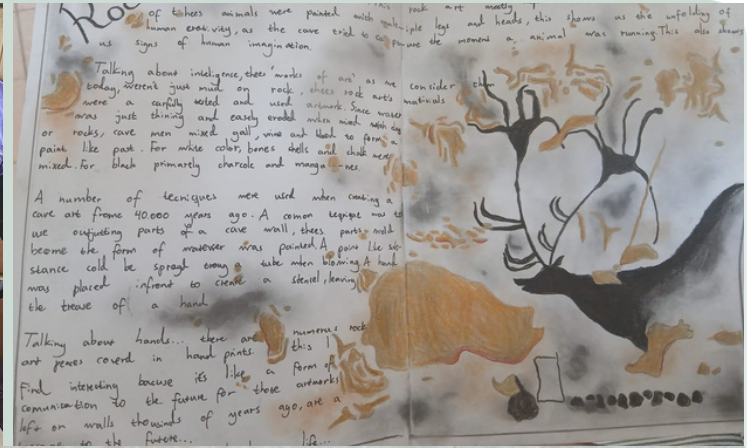


Music with Teacher Richard is in full swing and enjoyed by Class 6 and 7 and all our students.
