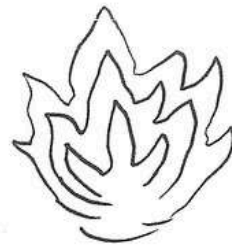
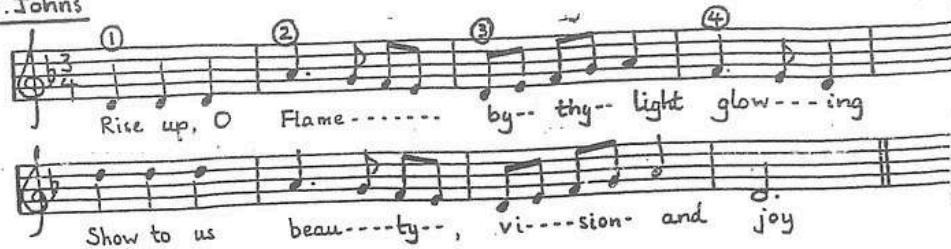

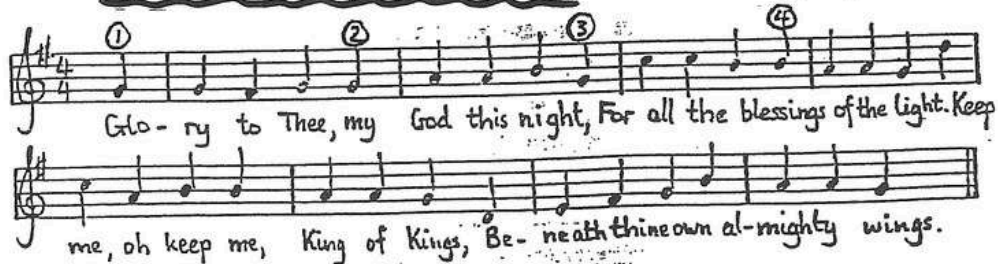

Tallis's Canon (1567, during reign of Elizabeth I)

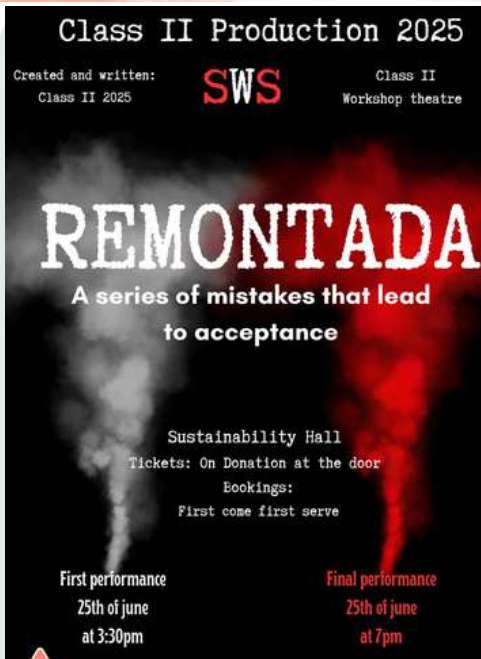


Evening Rise
